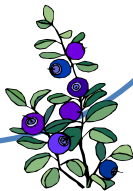

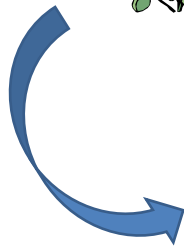

Matthew 10:37

Anyone who loves their father or mother more than me is not worthy of me. . . .

Look at your sons and daughters, mothers and fathers, and think about how much you love them . . . we need to love God even more.

(Ask another family to lead the group to this last stop.)

Proverbs 1:8, 9

Listen my child to the instruction of your father.

Ask the children: What has been the best advice your parents have given you? Why is it important to listen to your mom and dad? What good things have your mom and dad taught you?

(Let one of the smallest kids pick the next stop.)

Ephesians 5:22-25

Wives, submit to your husbands. . . .
Husbands, love your wives.

Husbands and wives share their love for each other. How is this an important step to a healthy family? Ask husbands and wives to pray together while the children listen.

(A husband and wife can agree on the spot to lead the group to.)

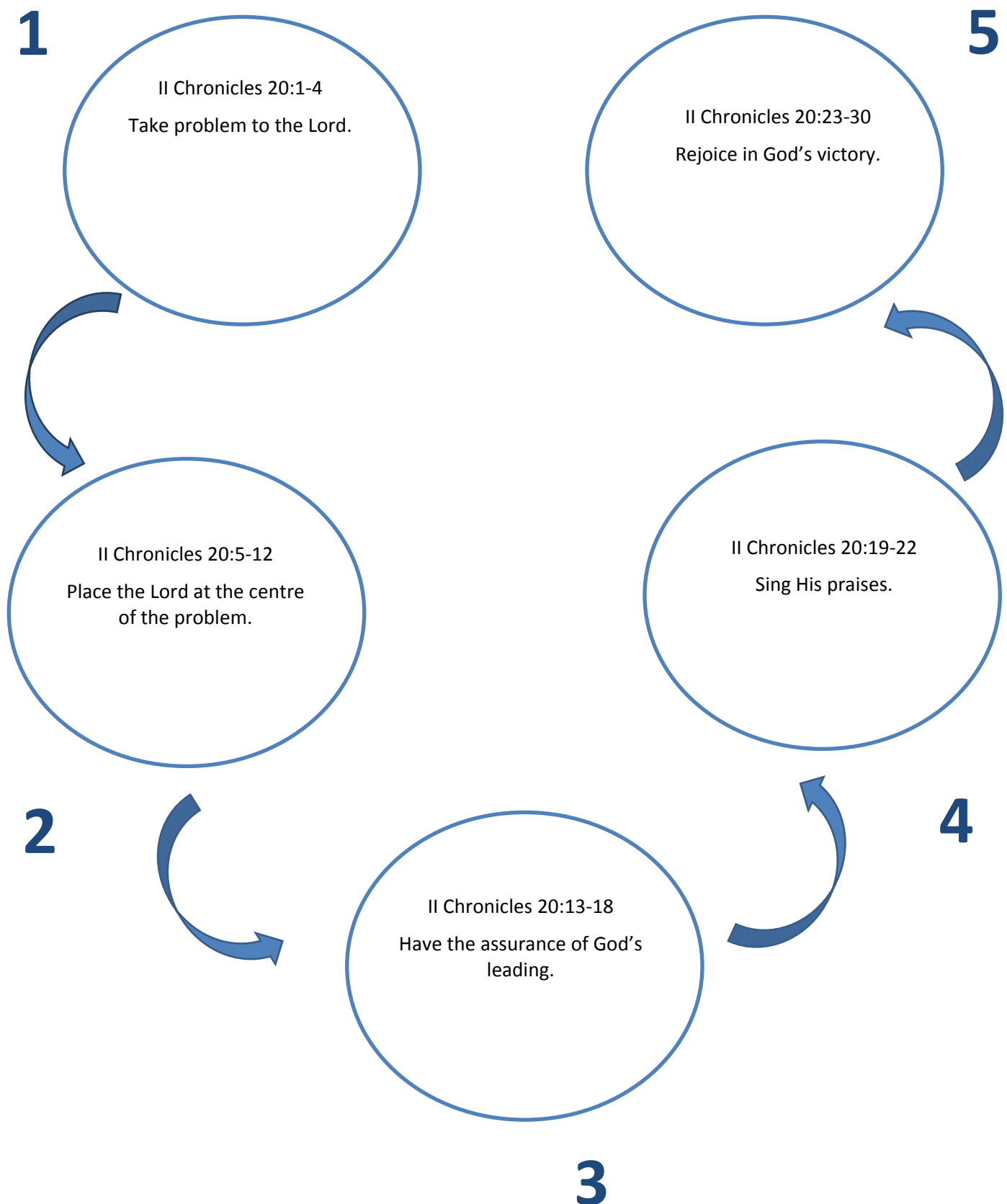

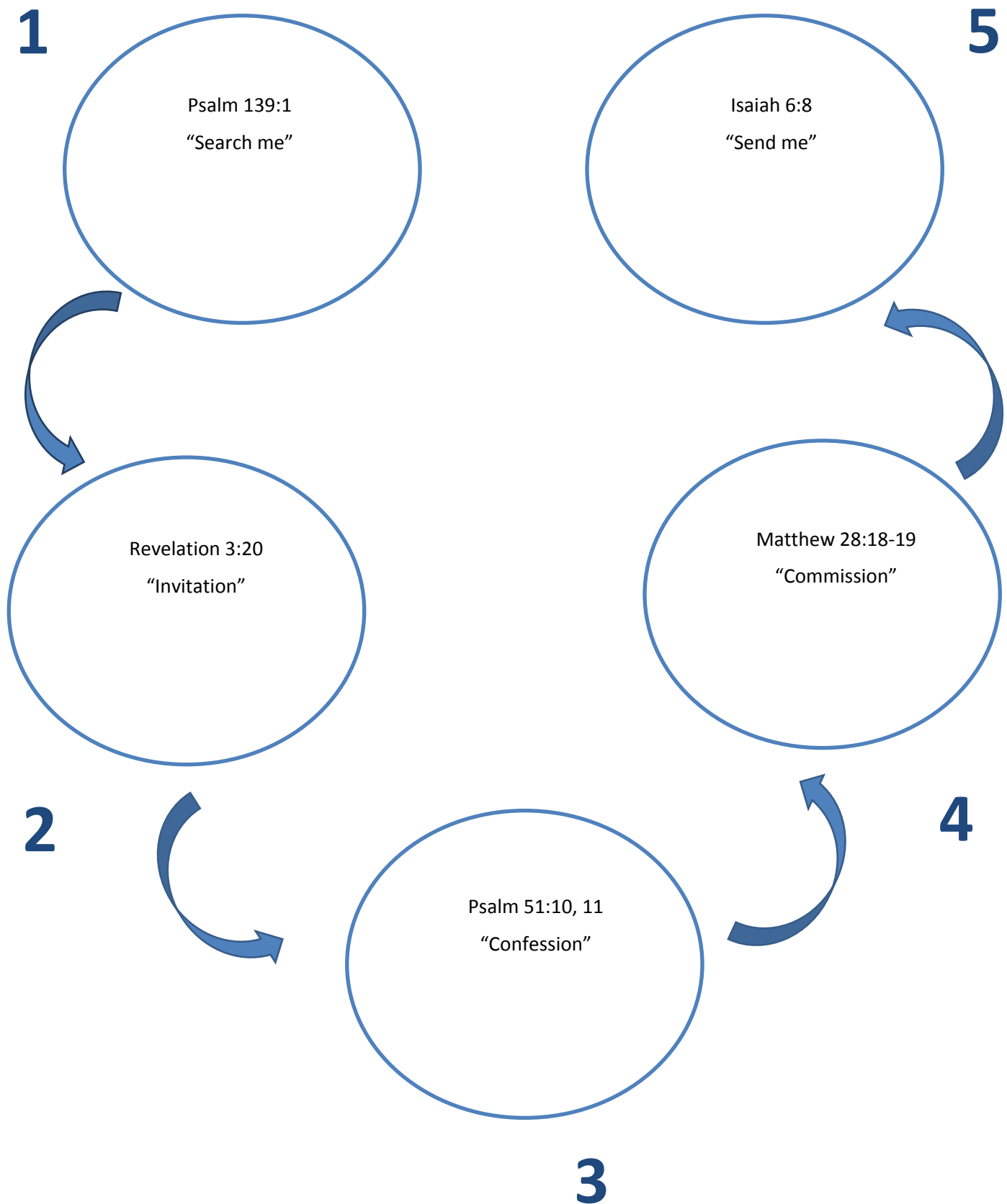

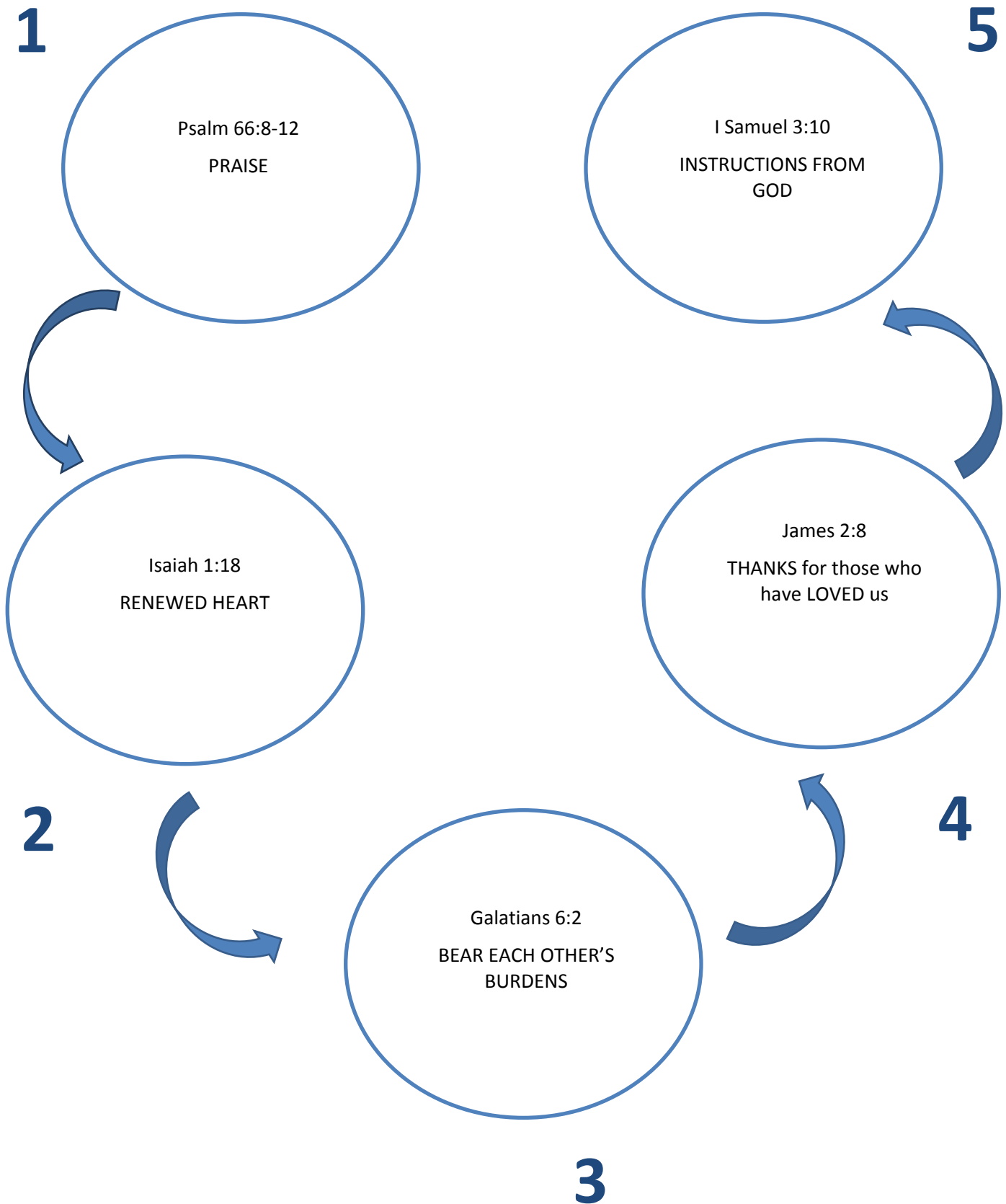


JOURNEY OF PURPOSE Prayer Walk





JOURNEY TOGETHER Prayer Walk

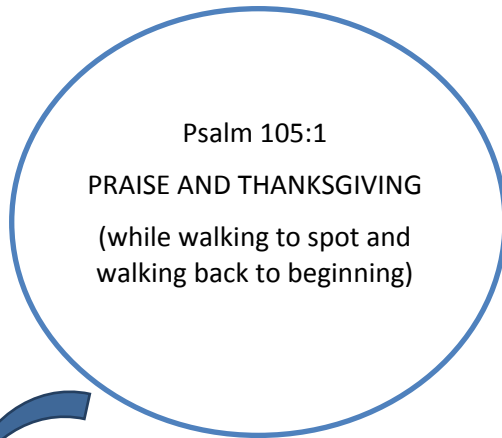




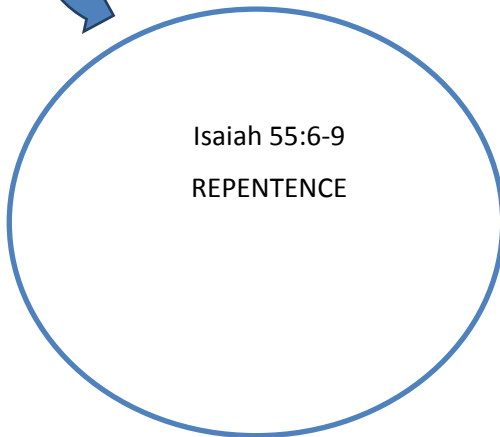
"KINETIC" Prayer Walk



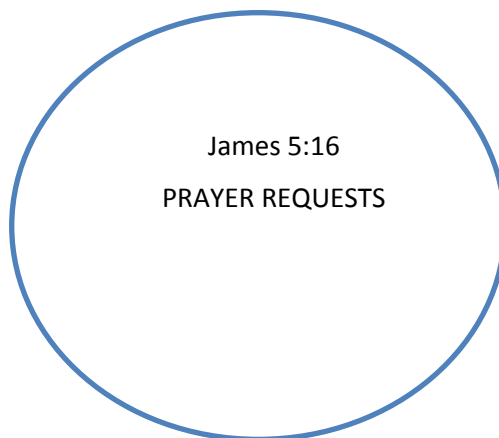

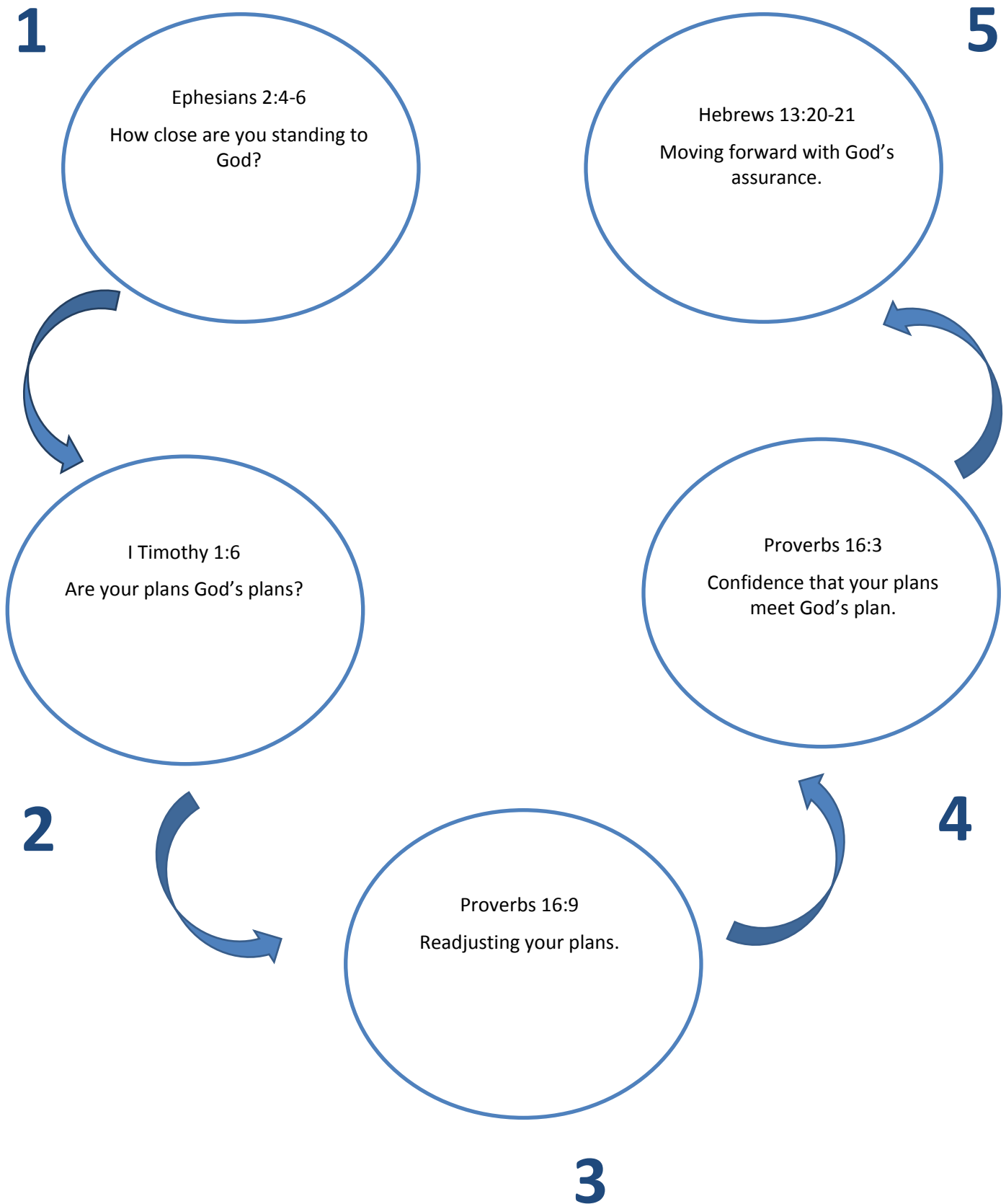


KNOWING AND BEING KNOWN

Prayer Walk



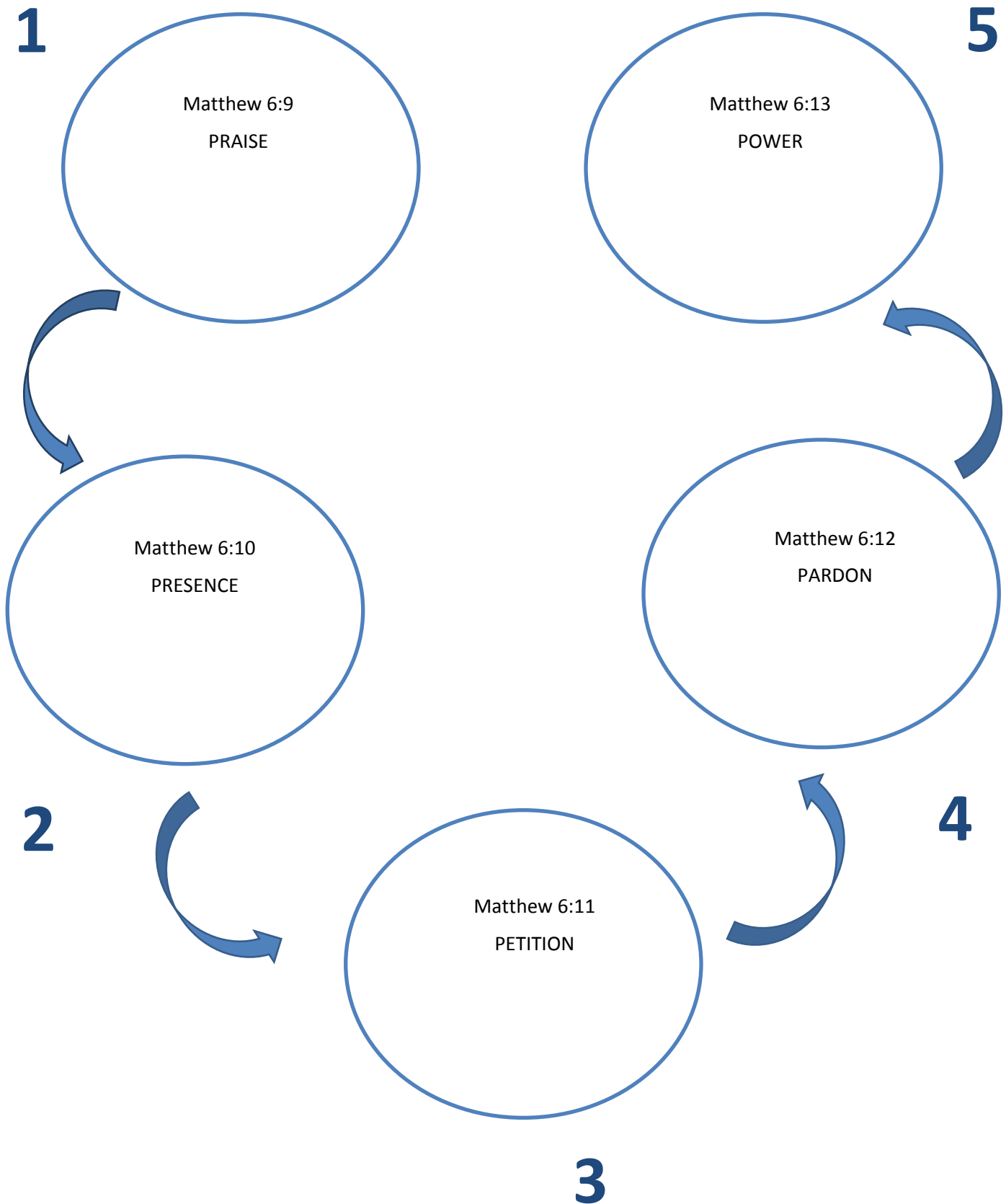

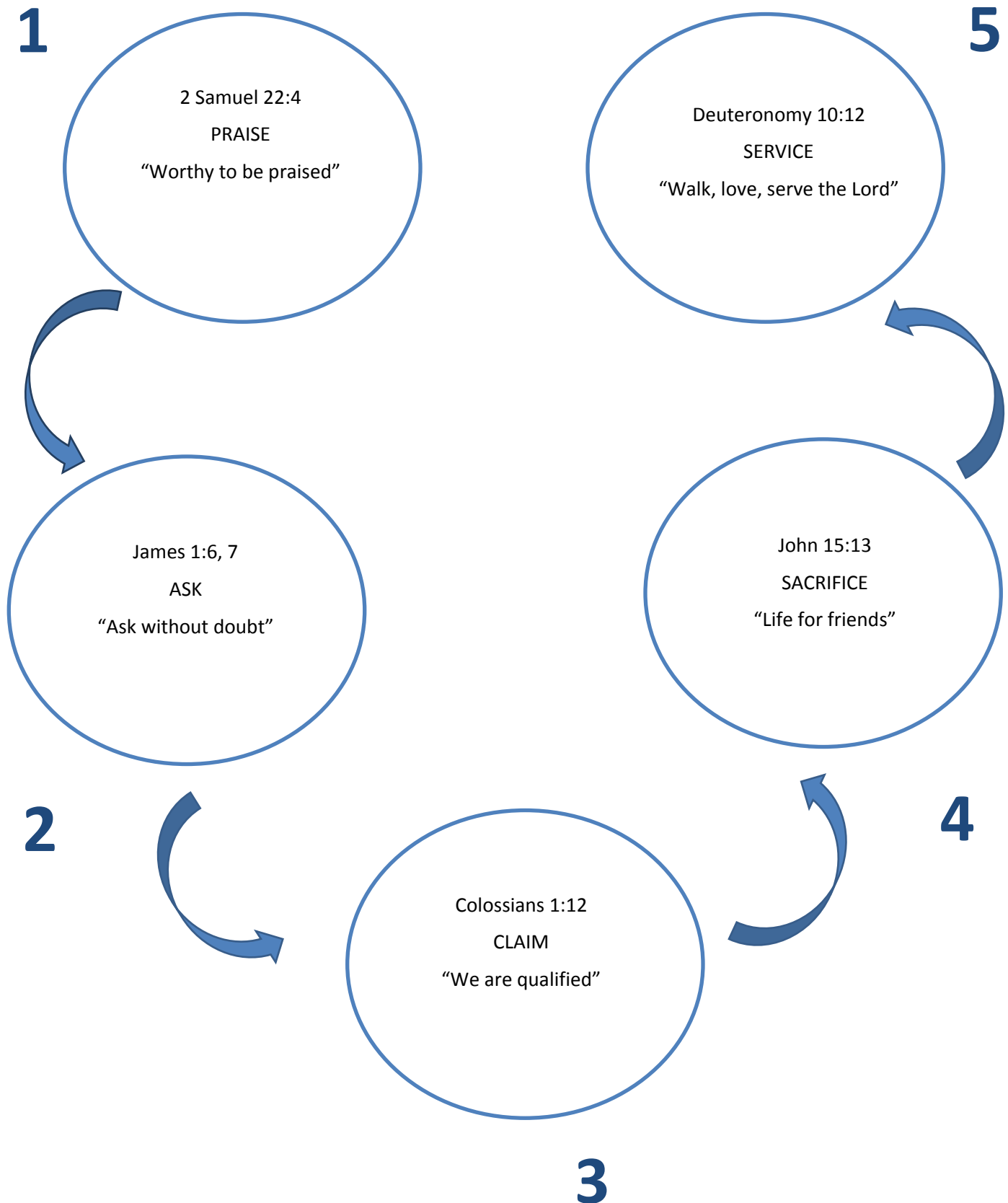
The LORD'S PRAYER Prayer Walk

Genesis 1:27

RECOGNIZE: You are created by God; you are God's image.

Ask: Do you believe you are created by God? If yes, what do you believe is your best God-given attribute? If no, what do you need to believe that God created you?

Pray: Thank God or ask God to show you His power.

Hebrews 10:39

REVIVE: Don't shrink back, not destroyed

Ask: What can destroy your faith?

Pray: Ask God to keep your faith strong so you won't shrink back. We are God's children; therefore, we are not destroyed

RENEW: New Creation

Ask: What do you believe about yourself that doesn't reflect the image of God?

Pray: Ask God to help you change into God's image.

Ask: What are your hopes for the future?

Pray: Ask God what His plans are for you.

REFLECT: Be holy. God is holy.

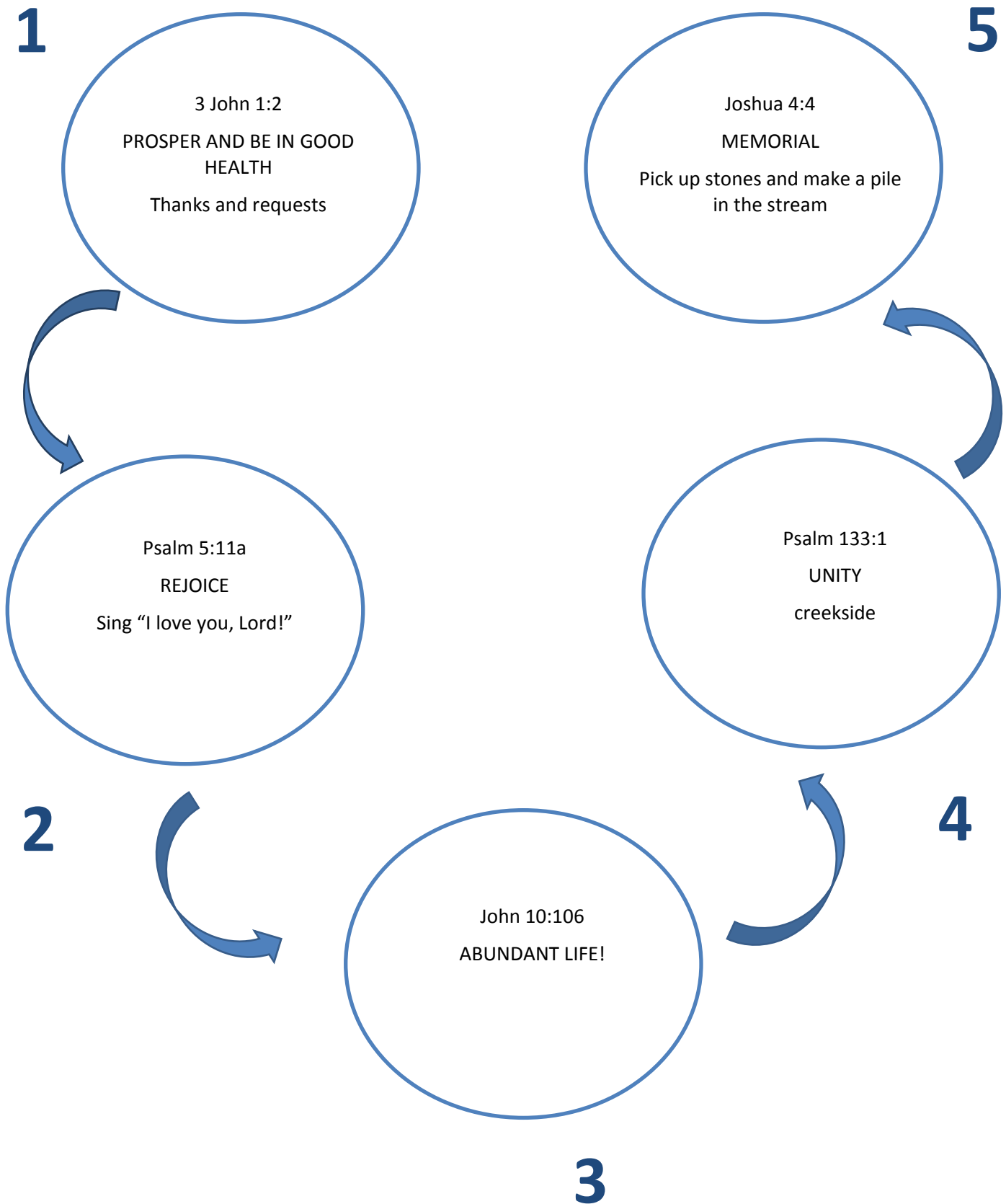
Ask: What does it mean to be holy? (one-word answers)

Exercise: Ask members what they would take to a baby shower to celebrate and anticipate a baby who hasn't come yet.

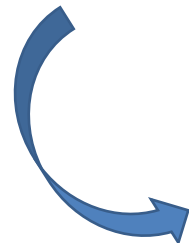

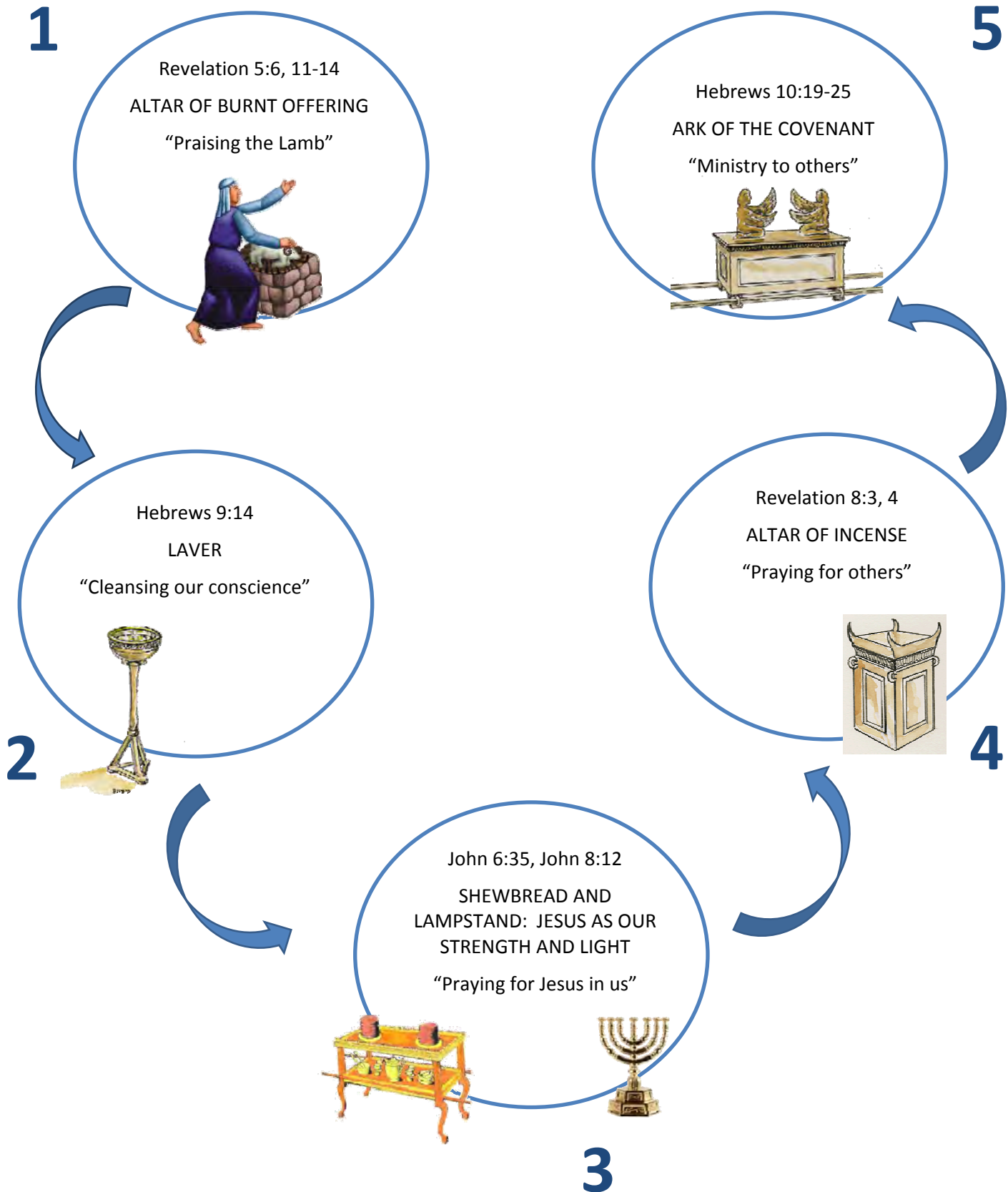
