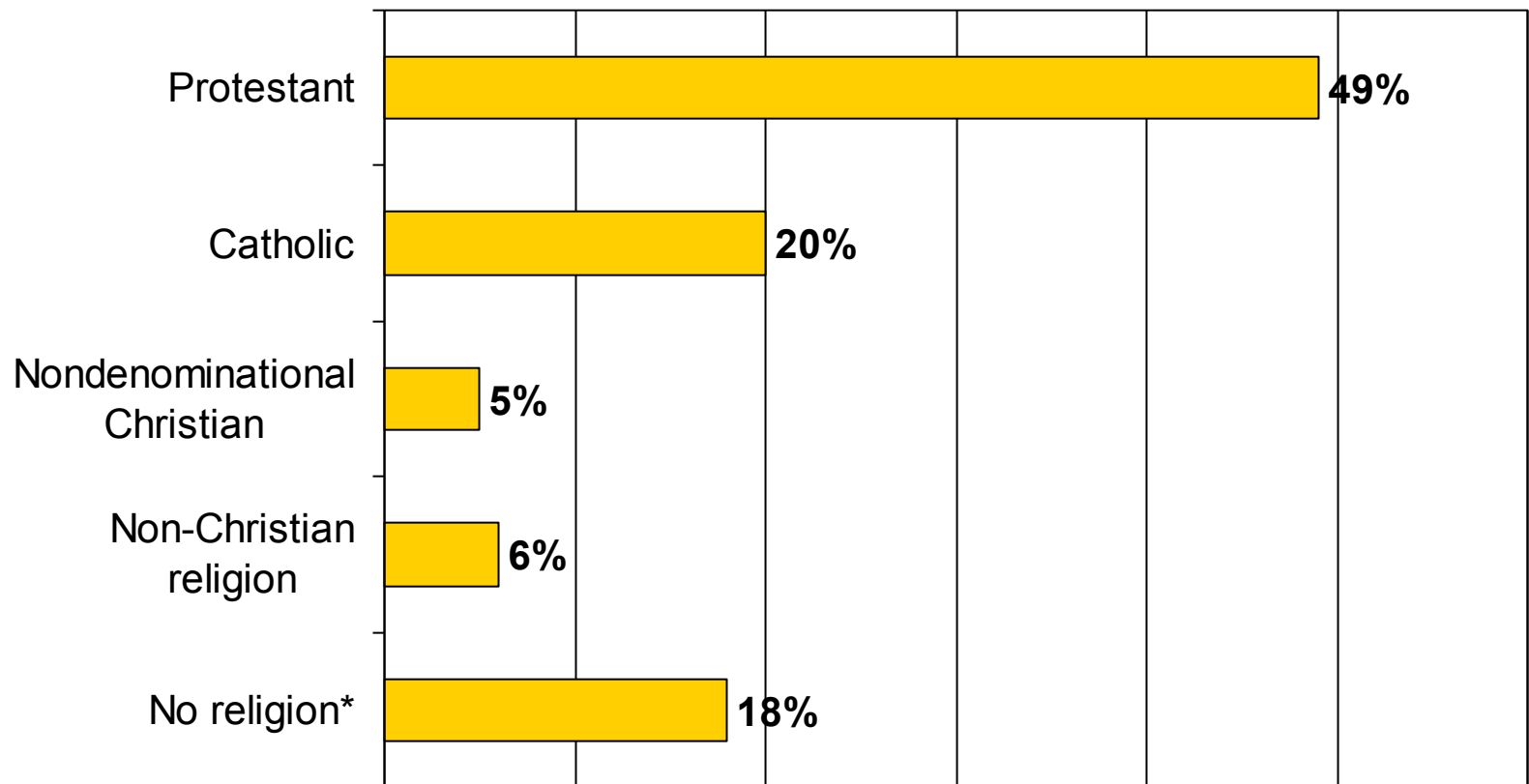
# Source of Data

---

- A random sample of 1,203 telephone interviews conducted November 7-11, 2012, immediately after the recent election.
- The standard allowance for sampling error in a sample this size is two percentage points, plus or minus.

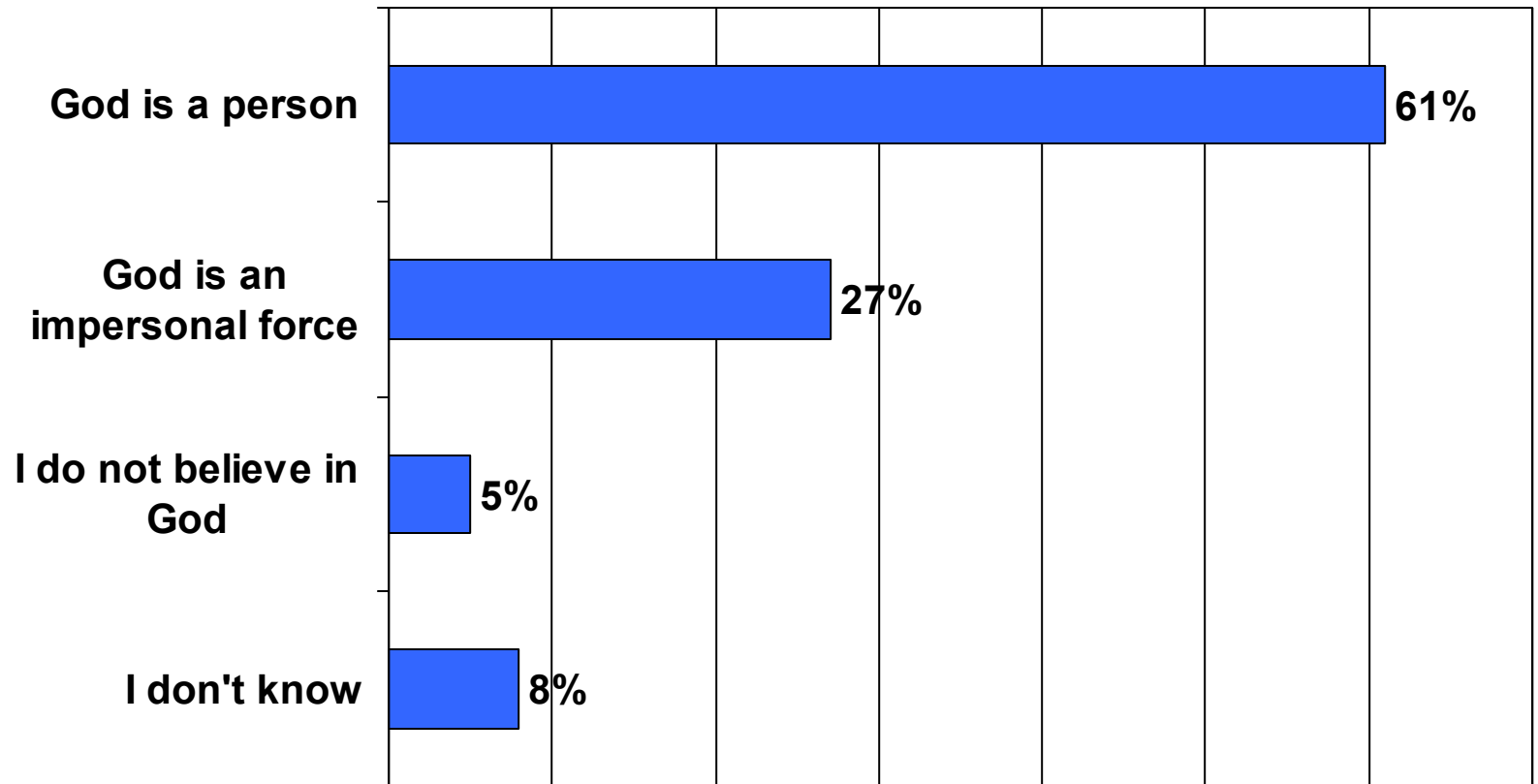


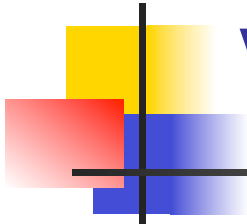
# How important is religion in your life?



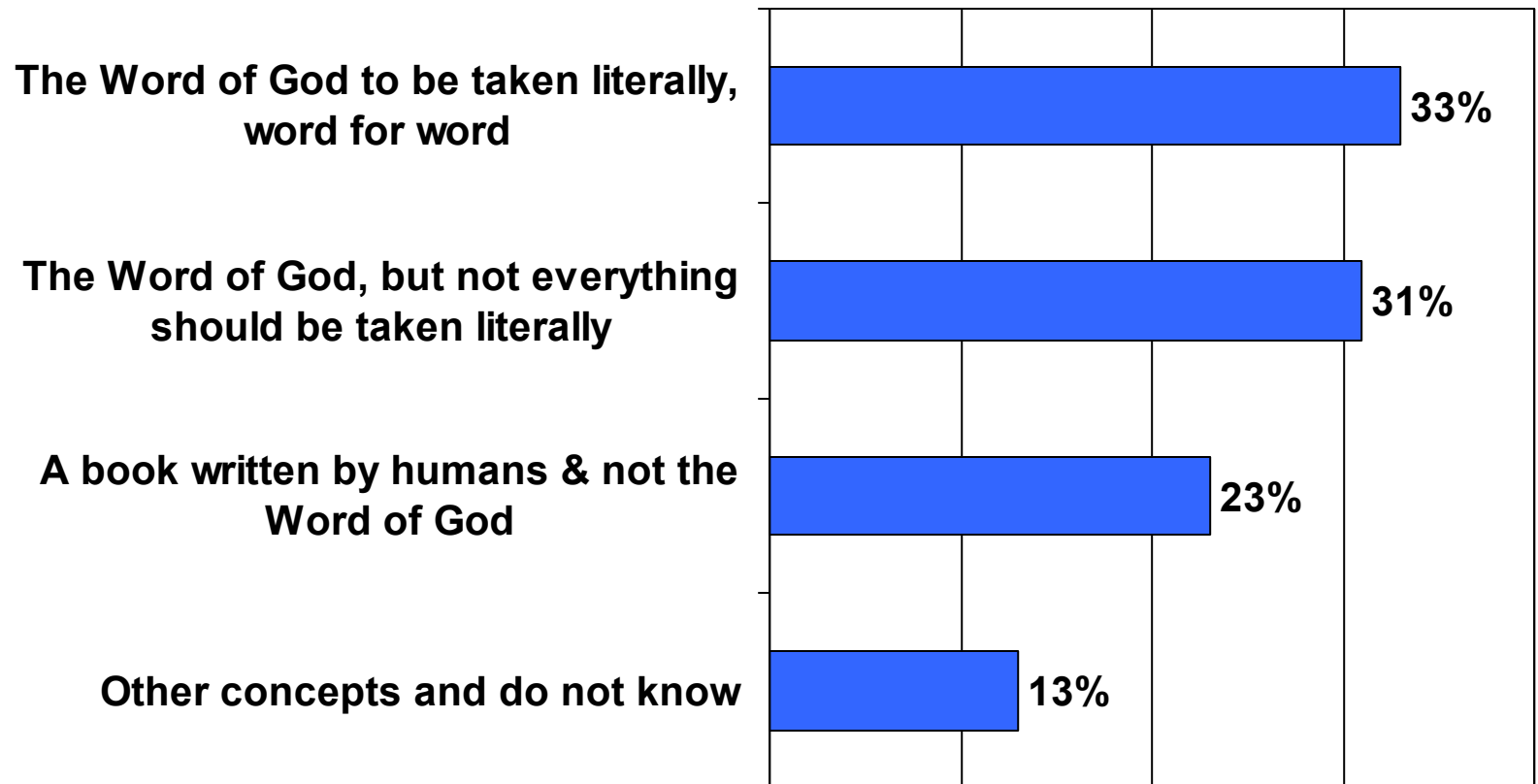


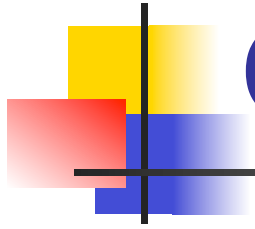

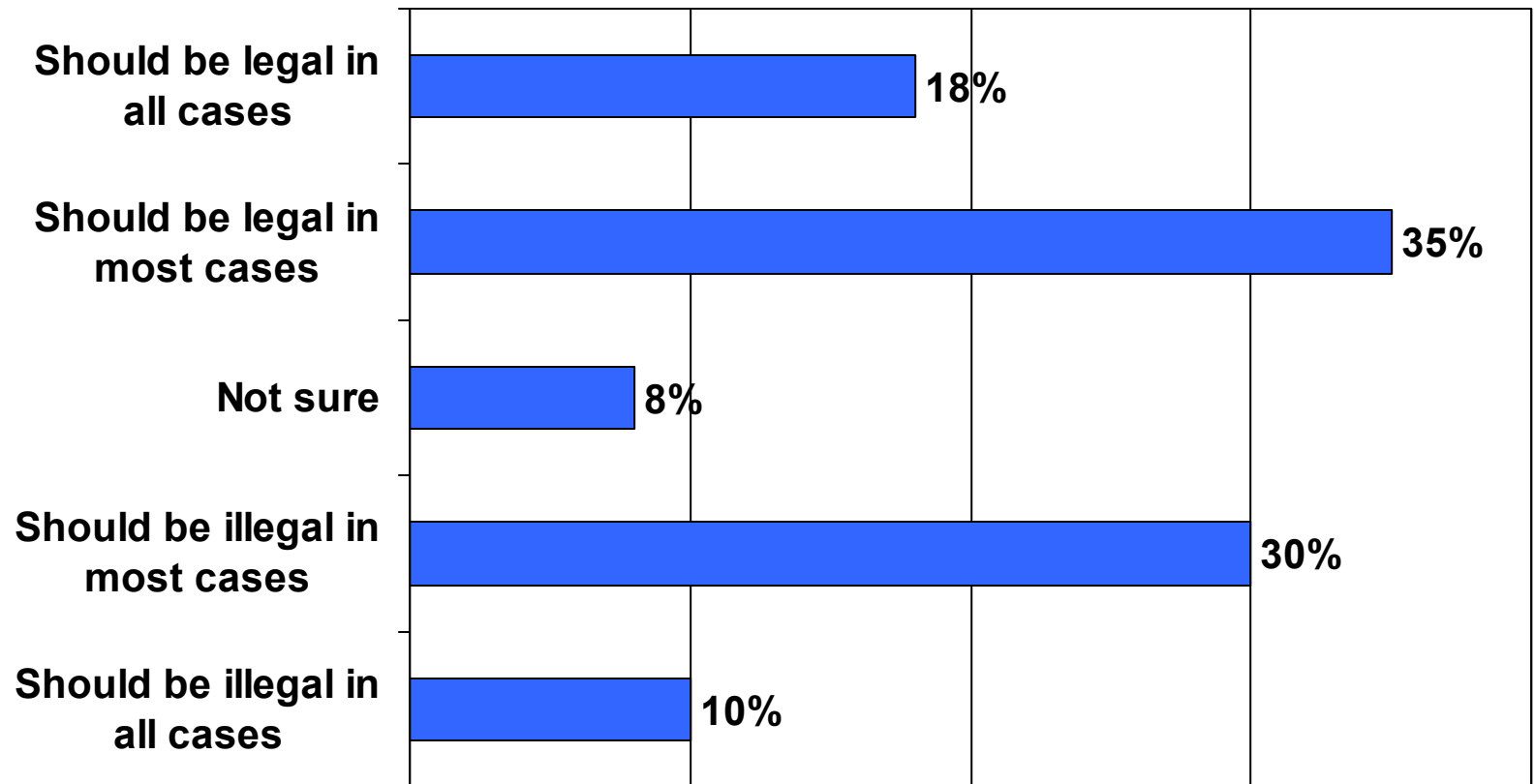

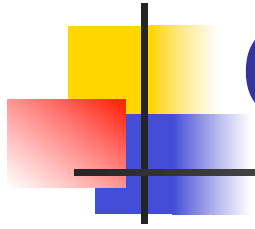




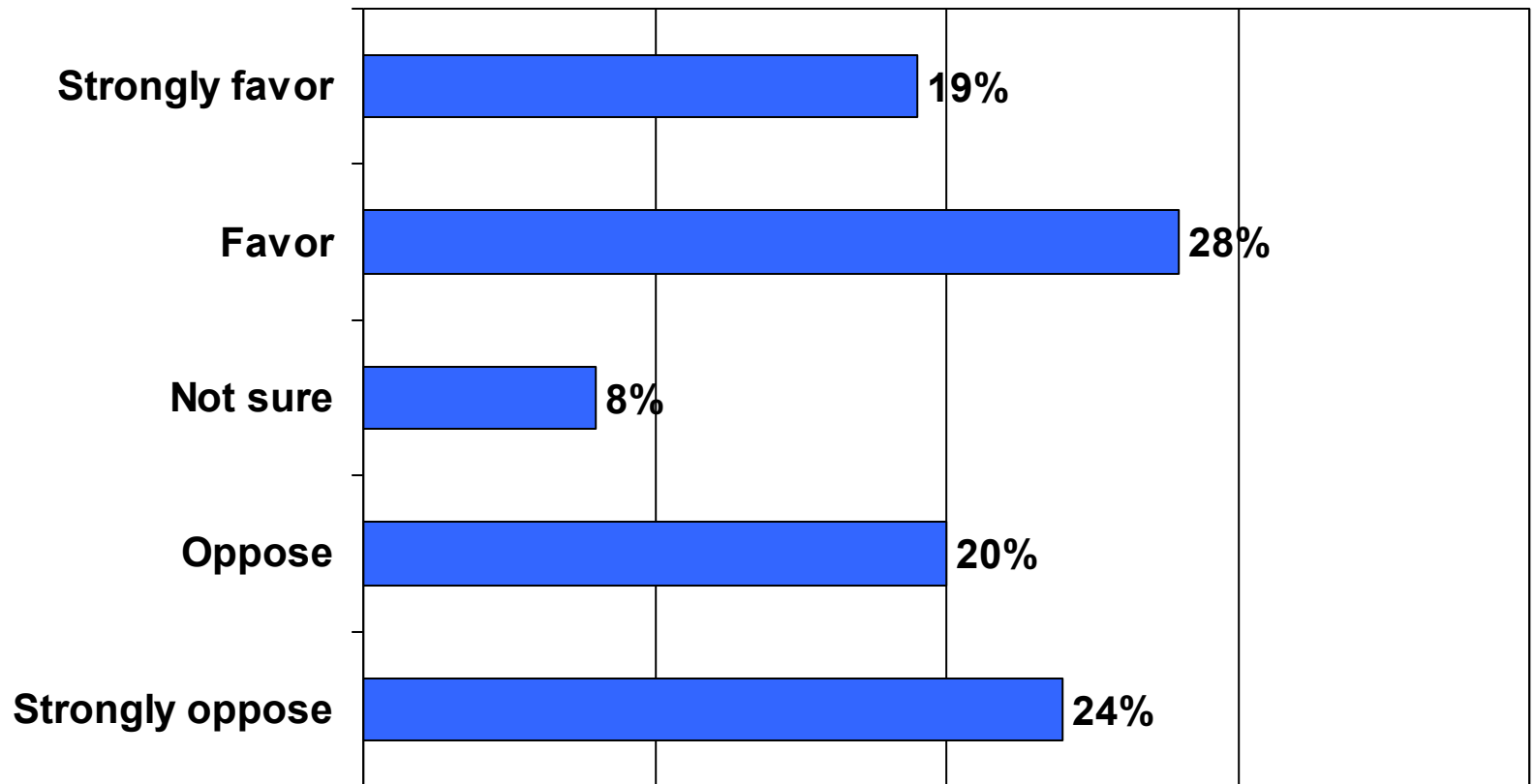
# Opinion on Abortion





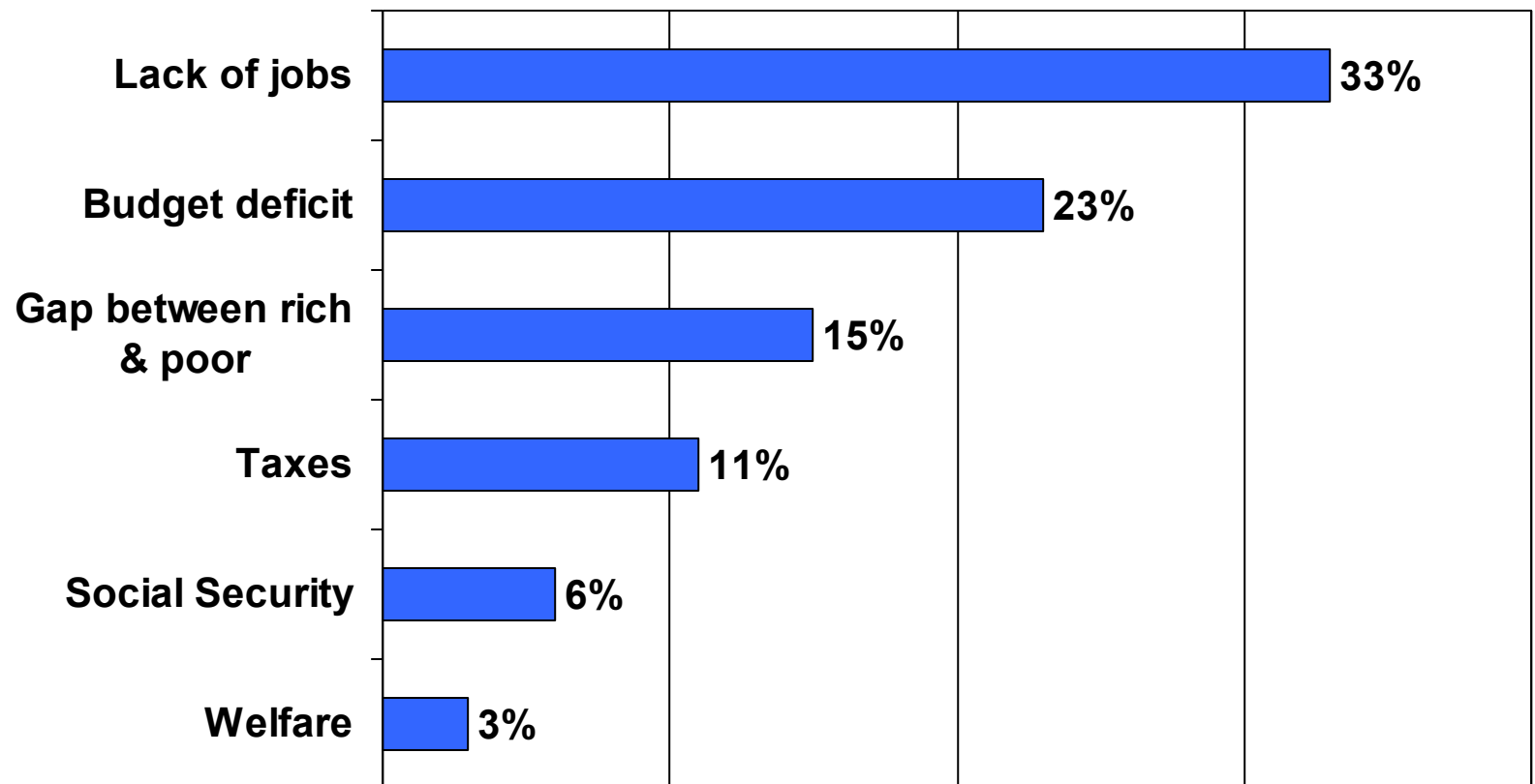


# Opinion on Same-sex Marriage





# What economic issues were important in deciding how you voted?

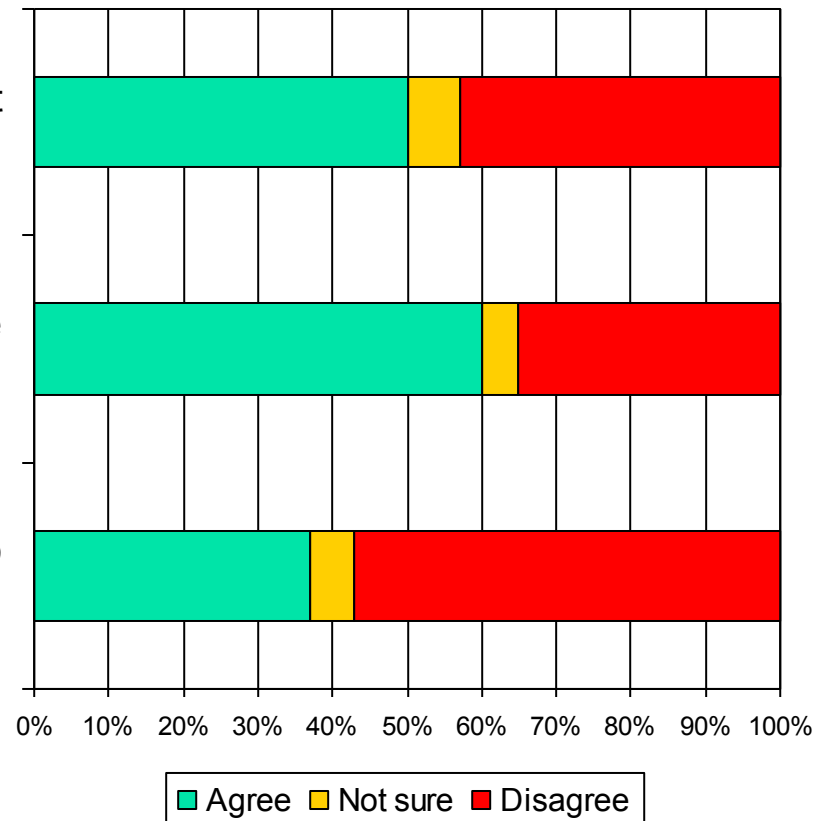

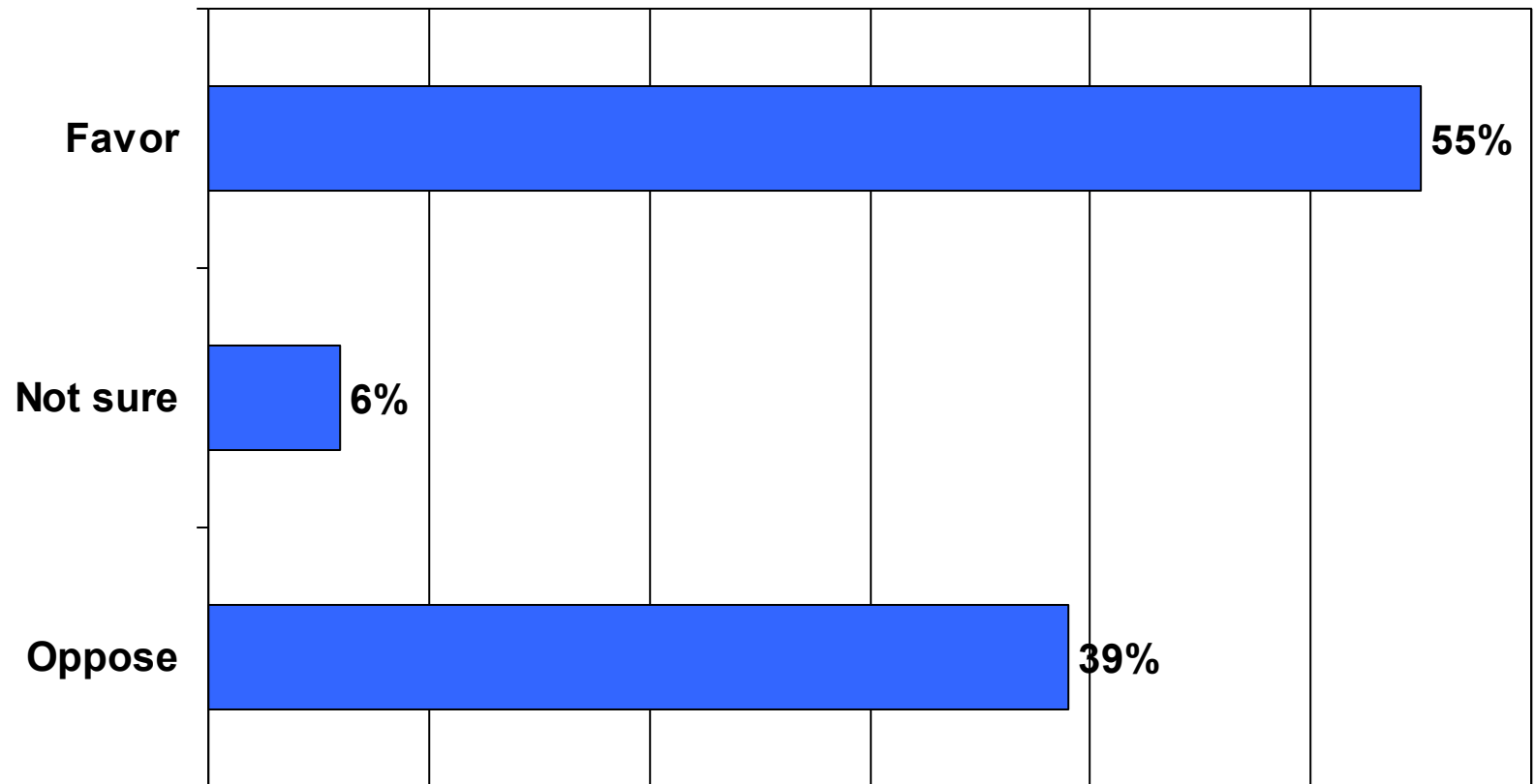
Government is providing social services that should be provided by religious charities.

Government should do more to reduce the gap between rich and poor.

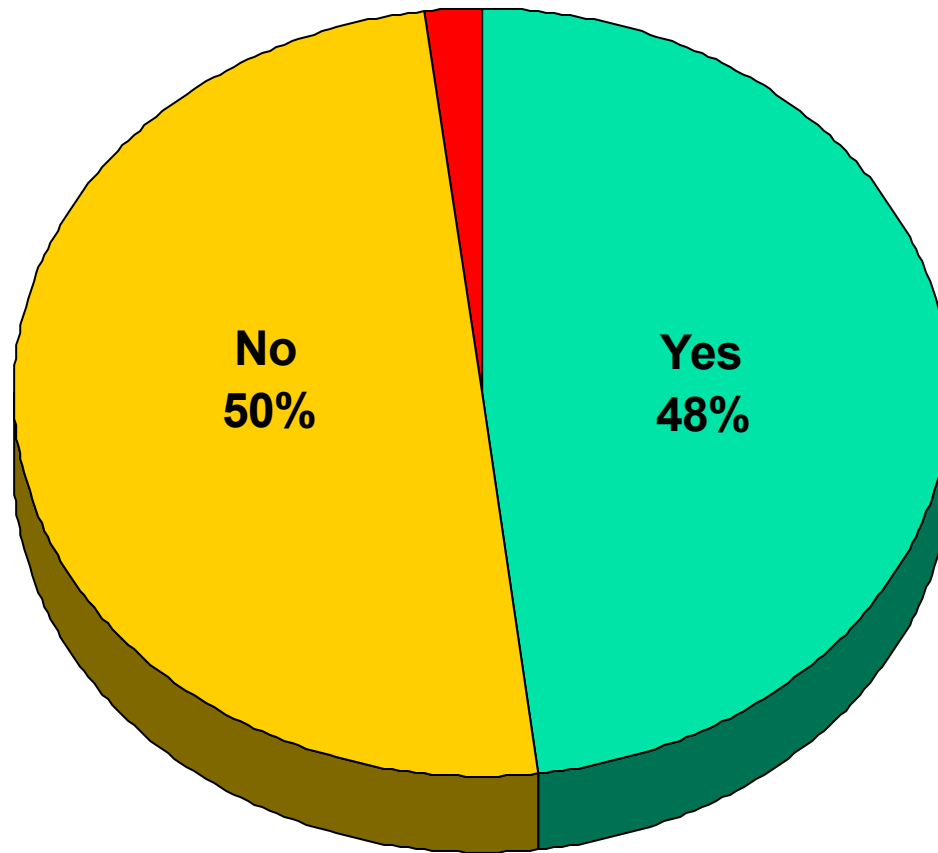
Government has paid too much attention to the problems of ethnic minorities.



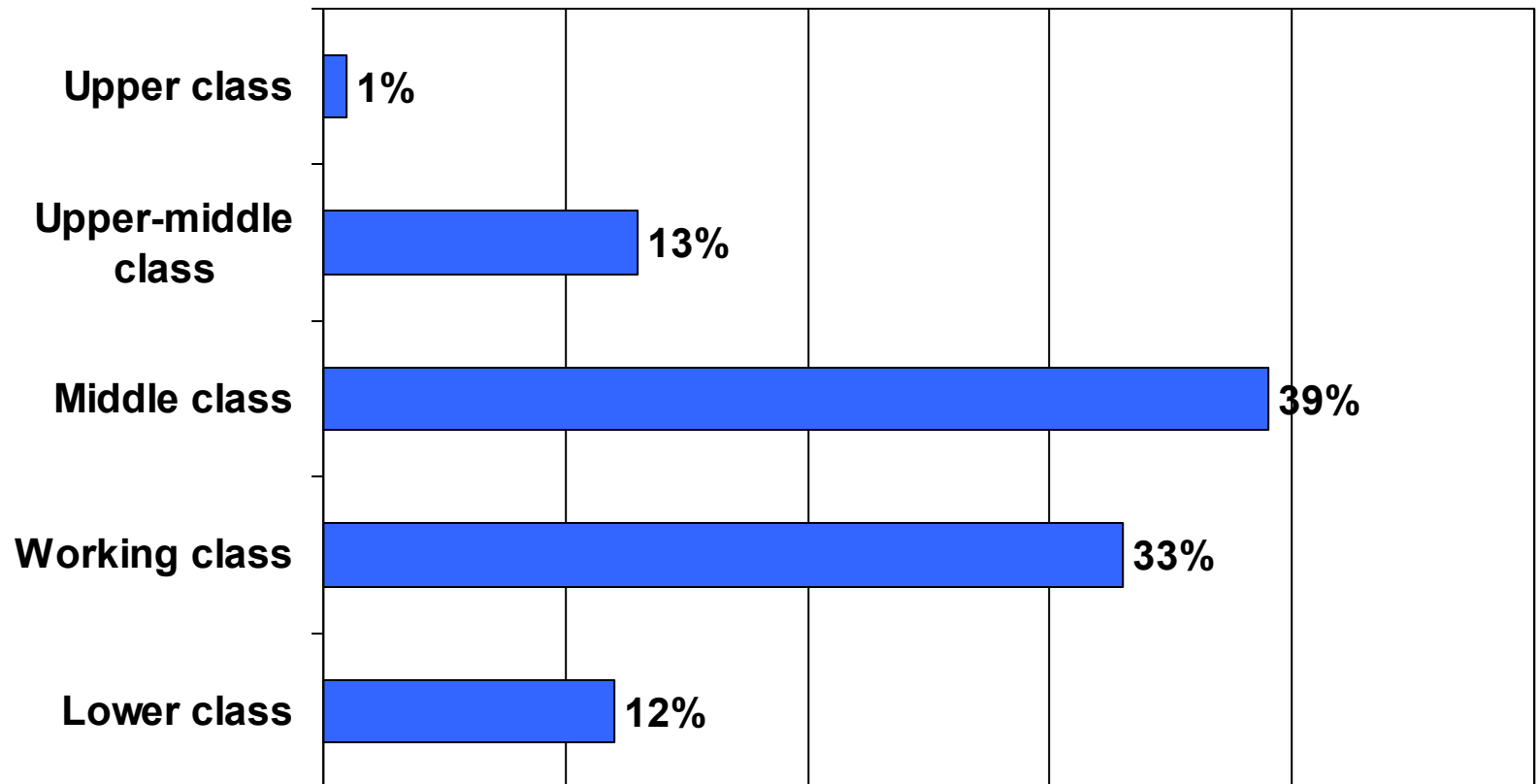
Illegal immigrants brought to the US as children should be allowed to gain legal status if they join the military or go to college.
