
### Awareness of the Adventist Church in Parkersburg, West Virginia

# What is the first thing that comes to mind when you hear ...?

Percentages are of the 68% who answered the initial question "yes." In the final report, these will recalculated to be percentages of the whole sample and therefore will be about two-thirds of the number listed here:

- 53% Nothing or "it is a religion/church"
- 25% Sabbath, Saturday, etc.
- 6% Misidentify as Mormon or JWs
- 3% Religion is deceptive; anti-religion
- 3% Mentioned a personal contact
- 2% They are good people
- 2% Don't like their door to door work
- -2% Health or diet connection

#### Personal Contact With an Adventist

Percentages are of the 68% who answered the initial question "yes." In the final report, these will recalculated to be percentages of the whole sample and therefore will be about two-thirds of the number listed here:

- 16% Know an Adventist at work/community
- 15% Contact with Adventist Community Svcs
- 11% Visited an Adventist church/meeting
- 6% Have an Adventist relative
- 2% Has been in an Adventist hospital

### Name Recognition of Ministries

- 24% Voice of Prophecy

- -9% Breath of Life
- -7% ADRA
