
## Background

- Branch Sabbath School started in Ravenna in 1903
- First pastor assigned in 1907
- Organized as a church with 19 members on December 12, 1908
- Started a church school in the fall of 1909 and it continued for 25 years
- Purchased first building in 1911

## Background

- Evangelism campaign in Masonic Temple in spring of 1948
- Campaign in Kent in spring of 1949
- Groundbreaking for new building on August 25, 1957
- Airatorium meetings in fall of 1960
- New building dedicated March 25, 1961
- Yeagley-Sickler campaign in 1963
- County Faith booth in 1964


#### Ravenna as a Mission Field

- Who are these people? How do they make a living? What are their needs?







## Over 65 Years of Age

## Information from Civic Agencies: Community Needs

- Slowing of the economy
- People losing their homes
- Finding jobs/job training
- Poverty has increased significantly in the last six years
- Healthy Community Partnership

#### Health Indicators

- 20% get no exercise
  - 58% of children get no exercise
  - 16% exercise outside of school compared to 64% nationally
- 15% are chronic alcohol users as compared to 5% nationally
  - 40% of adolescents have used alcohol in the last 30 days
- 19% of adults smoke
  - 17% of adolescents

#### Health Indicators

- More than 10% of adults have no health coverage
- One in five eligible children are not registered with Medicaid
  - Half get no dental care
- Nine percent of mothers get no prenatal care
- One in five pregnant women smoke
- 26% of women over 40 have not had a mammogram in the last year

#### Mental Health Indicators

- One in five adults has mental health or substance abuse disorders
  - 15% of adolescents compared to 5% across the State of Ohio
- 35% have been treated for MH problems in the last year, compared to 20% nationally
  - 22% of adolescents, compared to 16%

# Adult Mental Health Problems (2005)

- 28% Depression
- 18% Bipolar disorders
- 14% Alcohol dependence
- 11% Anxiety disorders
- 9% Adjustment disorders
- 8% Psychotic conditions
- 8% Drug abuse

# Adolescent Mental Health Problems (2005)

- 36% Attention deficit/behavior
- 28% Adjustment disorders
- 12% Bipolar disorders
- 9% Anxiety disorders
- 7% Depression
- 2% Drug abuse

#### **Extension Service Survey**

- 90% of residents agree that "We need to preserve agricultural land in Portage County."
- 91% agree, "People move to Portage County for its rural character."
- 68% agree, "Portage County is a farming community."


#### No Child Left Behind

- 34 out of 132 elementary schools in Portage County have a performance index below 50 percent
  - This includes private and parochial schools


### Survey of Congregation

- A total of 26 usable questionnaires were returned which represents the majority of the typical Sabbath attendance.














## Observed to be Most Effective Methods to Bring in New Members








## Visibility of the Adventist Church in this Metropolitan Area

## Do you belong to a service club or civic group of some kind?





### **Analysis**

- Research has shown that growth in Adventist churches comes from:
  - Community involvement
  - Rich spirituality
  - Intentionality (goals, planning)
  - A positive atmosphere in congregation
  - Activities for the unchurched on Sabbath

#### Recommendations

- Join the Health Community Partnership
- Interview community leaders for their input
- Start a stress seminar and support group for the unemployed
- Study the possibility of opening a thrift store/youth drop-in center
- Appoint a communication officer (and possibly get training)

#### Recommendations

- Have a monthly PIE meeting (People in Evangelism) to share experiences and provide training in Friendship Evangelism
- Convene a meeting of the members who are under 45 years of age and ask them to make recommendations as to how to engage more young adults
