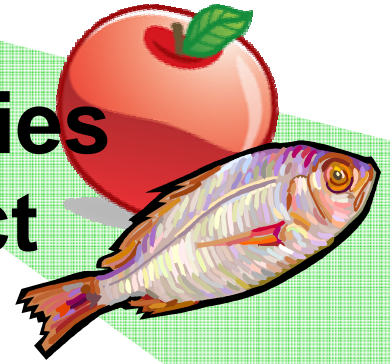


# Endangered Species Research Project

- A. Research Report (700-1000 words)
1. Literature search - Reader's Guide to Periodical Literature
  2. Complete outline/note cards
  3. Rough draft
  4. Typed, double spaced on computer
  5. Correct spelling and grammar
  6. Title page
  7. Complete bibliography - 6 sources minimum
    - 1 Encyclopedia
    - 3 Periodicals
    - 2 Internet sources
  8. Content:
    - a. Description of species (scientific name must be included)
    - b. Habitat/Range (map must be included)
    - c. Natural history
    - d. Ecological importance
    - e. Current status
    - f. Reason for species decline
    - g. Recovery efforts
- B. Develop a large (18"X24") 4-color poster that depicts the natural history of your species.
