

# Every Moment Devotions

**Purpose:** To learn how to allow God to speak to you all the time and anywhere

Often a devotional time is thought of as being in a certain place at a certain time with a certain book. And though this is true, it can also be true that God can speak to you through a variety of ways. Jesus saw his life and journey on this earth as a constant and continual walk and talk with his Father in heaven. We can learn to keep our communication with God open all the time and anywhere. It takes practice as well a willingness to be open to allowing yourself to see life as a continual communion with God like Jesus did. Here are some ways in which you can let this happen in your life.

**Procedure:**

**Memorize and meditate on a scripture** verse throughout the day and as you go about your daily routine see how God can use that verse to apply to what you are going through that day

**Talk to God** as you would a companion that is RIGHT NEXT TO YOU as you go through your daily activities

Praise him **throughout the day** as He reveals Himself to you by audibly saying:

- Thank you Lord!
- Help Me Lord!
- Amen!
- God is Good!
- I'll be praying for you!
- Create Your Own!!!

Allow your self to **SEE GOD** in the people, things and places that He puts in your path each day.

- See the things He puts in your path as OBJECT LESSONS for you that particular day, (even everyday objects like: computers, paper, windows, mirrors, water, soap, clothes, napkins...
- You can create your own reflection thoughts about what God wants you to learn for that day rather than using the thoughts and reflections of someone else.

**Keep** a small tract, bible, booklet, or bible verse card close by you at all times so that when you have some down time you can read and meditate on the thoughts presented in the material.

Devotions don't have to be long, they just need to be **sincere and intentional**.

It's like going by a water fountain...you can pass it by...or... you can get a wonderful refreshing drink....Jesus' says, He is the "Living water," that never runs dry.

## **Spiritual Application**

God is Everyway....Don't think a devotional life has to be the same everyday...Jesus is wanting to walk and talk with you ALL THE DAY long, not just at one time or place...God Bless you
