Fractal Art

Grade levels: 1-2

Content Areas: Art, Bible

Description/Abstract of Lesson:

Students will learn about fractal art and how we see God's patterns and design in nature

Time Requirements:

Preparation Time: 5 min. Class Time: 30 min.

Standards Addressed:

J2E- 9,1

Specific Learning Outcomes:

Head (know): The student will know that God has an organized plan for creation Heart(feel): The student will feel a since of awe when looking at creation. Hand (do/respond): Students will draw and color fractals.

Assessment of Outcomes: Creation and display of a fractal drawing.

Learning Experiences:

- 1. Define a fractal.
- 2. Read Ecc1. 7:13 (The Message)
- 3. Say: Take a good look at God's work. Who could simplify and reduce Creation's curves and angles into a plain straight line?
- 4. Show students pictures of fractals in nature (http://sprott.physics.wisc.edu/fractals.htm offers some) or check out books from your local library.
- 5. Teacher demonstration of how to make fractals.
- 6. Students draw and color their fractal pictures (make sure patterns repeat)
- 7. Discussion about God's amazing, beauty, and organization in creation.
- 8. Wrap up by summarizing Eccl. 7:13.

Required Materials: Pictures of fractals and /or web site to display fractals.
