**Topic:** Learning How to Search the Internet  
**Aim:** Usage of the Computer for Narrow Internet Searches  
Application of the Internet to Spiritual Resource Location

**Materials:**

1. Computer
2. Internet Connection
3. LCD Projector

**Lesson:**

**1. Motivating the Lesson**

- a. Use the Bible to locate a specific Bible verse. Clarify that this is the process of searching- by definition, looking through a body of information for something specific.
- b. Send children on a library hunt for a specific book, but only provide very specific and limited details to aid the search.

**2. Teaching Students about Searching on the Computer**

- a. Introduce students to computer search engines that are reliable
  - i. **What is a search engine?** A place on the internet that allows us to place a question, word or phrase and return lists of information.
  - ii. **List of Search Engines:** Google, Askjeeves.com, msn.com, yahoo.com
  - iii. **Key Search words:** and, or, using apostrophes and quotations
- b. Demonstrate the use of a computer for searching
  - i. **Type in Tom** – show that the search is very vague
  - ii. **Type in Tom and Jerry** – show that the results reduce
  - iii. **Type in Tom and Brady** - show that the results become more specific

**3. Have the students attempt to search for internet information about the teacher.**

**Summary**

Students will demonstrate the ability to effectively search the internet for information relevant to specific subject matter.

**Assessment**

Students will search the internet for their Sabbath school lesson for the week.
