

Partnerships with Parents

The Seventh-day Adventist philosophy emphasizes the importance of the home, school, and church working together for the good of each child. The following resources are designed to assist parents in faith building in the home.

1. Communicate spiritual ideas/spiritual themes being emphasized in the classroom with parents through a news letter or daily communiqué.
2. Send home a list of daily memory verses/daily character traits being emphasized
3. Homework assignments which emphasize students sharing with their parents what they have learned at school.
4. [MOPS](#) (Mothers of Pre-Schoolers): Parents getting together at the school on a weekly basis to pray for school/student needs.
5. Outreach activities which encourage parent/student involvement.
6. Parents bringing their lunch to school and eating with the students. If Bible is taught just prior to lunch, parent will understand what their children are being taught.
