Description/Abstract of Lesson

This is a complimentary assignment for the lesson on the Plagues of Egypt. With a little research on the Egyptian gods and goddesses, there are some strong connections perceivable between the plagues and the supposed powers of the ancient mythological deities. Show the students how God breaks down this tradition with the plagues! I also recommend making a complementary PowerPoint for your students to view the perceptions of each god/goddess.

Plague	Diety	Power
Nile to Blood	Hapi	Nile god
Frogs	Heqt	Fertility/abundance (shaped like a frog)
Gnats	Geb	(they come out of the dust of the ground)
Flies/Lice	Nut	(they come out of the sky)
Livestock	Hathor	Livestock
Boils	Isis	Healing
Hail	Seth	Storms/Chaos
Locusts	Osiris	Agriculture (notice his green face)
Darkness	Ra	Sun (check out what they believed about a snake swallowing the sun as being an evil omen...and remember what happened with Moses, Aaron, and the superior snake)
Death of the 1 st Born	Pharaoh	(Remember that they believed that the Pharaohs were themselves divine)
