<u>Sample Lesson Plan – Short Story Writing based on The Book of God – grades 9-12</u>

- Objectives:
 - Short story writing
 - o Cultural research
 - o Use of imagination (realistic)
 - o Bring Scripture to life, make it personal and relevant
- Journey to Excellence connections
 - Commitment to God
 - Commitment to the Church
 - o Family and Interpersonal Relationships
 - o Responsible Citizenship
 - o Healthy Balanced Living
 - o Intellectual Development
 - o Communication Skills
 - o Life Skills
 - o Aesthetic Appreciation
 - o Career and Service
- Materials
 - o Bible for each student KJV or NIV (no paraphrase)
 - Writing tools
 - o *The Book of God* (teacher only)
- Advanced preparation
 - o Choose example story from *The Book of God*
- Process
 - Teacher directed activities:
 - Teach the elements of the short story
 - Read chosen story from The Book of God
 - Discuss/determine elements of the short story in this story
 - Brainstorm list of potential Bible stories to rewrite...enough for one per student
 - o Student follow through:
 - read their story from KJV or NIV
 - List out the short story elements of their story
 - Research cultural background of their story
 - Write their story using their brainstorming, research and imagination to bring the Biblical story to life

- o Sharing and Evaluation:
 - Peer editing in small groups
 - Revision
 - Teacher evaluation
- o Publishing options:
 - Share with whole class
 - Read to an elementary class
 - Use it for Children's Story at church or elementary chapel program
 - Create a book of all the stories
- Curriculum Connections
 - o Bible
 - o History
 - o Technology
 - o Possibly math and/or science, depending on their story
 - o Art if they illustrate it
 - o Possibly home arts and/or music, depending on their story.
