

SIMPLE STEPS IN SHARING THE GOSPEL TRUTH WITH KIDS - I

1. There is only one true and living God. All other gods have been made up by man.

Ephesians 4:6 '... one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.'

Isaiah 44:6 'This is what the LORD says- Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD almighty: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God.'

2. God is the Creator. (by just speaking).

John 1:3 'Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.'

3. God is holy. He cannot sin.

Revelation 4:8 'Each of the four living creatures had six wings and was covered with eyes all around, even under his wings. Day and night they never stop saying: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come."

4. God is just. He is fair – not like a bad ref!

John 5:30 'By myself I can do nothing; I judge only as I hear, and my judgment is just, for I seek not to please myself but him who sent me.'

5. God loves you.

1 John 5:8 'Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.'

6. God is the Author. We know all this because God wrote it.

1 Timothy 3:16 'All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness'

7. I have sinned.

Romans 3:23 'for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God'

8. Sin needs to be punished

Romans 6:23 'For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.'

9. God had a plan

Isaiah 9:6 'For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on is shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.'

SIMPLE STEPS IN SHARING THE GOSPEL TRUTH WITH KIDS - II

10. The Lord Jesus is God's only Son

John 20:31 'But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.'

11. Jesus Died for Sinners

Romans 5:8 'But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us'

12. Jesus poured out His own blood

1 John 1:7 'But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.'

13. Jesus rose again

1 Corinthians 15:4-6 'that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that he appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve. ⁶After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

14. Jesus is ruler now

Ephesians 1:22 'And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church'

15. Jesus will come again

1 Thessalonians 4:13-17 'Brothers, we do not want you to be ignorant about those who fall asleep, or to grieve like the rest of men, who have no hope. ¹⁴We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. ¹⁵According to the Lord's own word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left till the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. ¹⁶For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.'
