

A Teacher's Quick Guide to Teaching About Ellen White And the Spirit of Prophecy

- **Do a biographical sketch on Ellen White. Suggested information to include:**
 - **Picture of Mrs. White**
 - **Full name (include maiden name)**
 - **Dates of birth and death**
 - **Who she married**
 - **Three significant points about her life**
- **Journal – Write about a spiritual gift that God has given you. How do you feel when you use it?**
- **Use the “Legacy of Light” CD. The Learning Center Segment teaches about Ellen White through paintings, puzzles, and memory games. (*Elementary*)**
- **Listen to segments of the “Pathways of the Pioneers” 22 compact disc.**
- **Read segments of Ellen White’s earlier works, such as her vision of heaven in early writings. (10+)**
- **Read stories from the megabook “He Taught Love” (Christ’s Object Lesson). E.g. The Little Lost Lamb, Are You My Neighbor, & The Runaway. (*Middle School*)**
- **Read and discuss the Youth Version of “Steps to Christ”. (*Middle School*)**
- **Read “A Call to Stand Apart” to deal with important issues faced by today’s young people.**
- **Have a youth Bible study on what the Bible says about extrabiblical prophets. Use;**
 - **Matt 24:24**
 - **Eph 4:11-13**
 - **Rev 12:17**
 - **Amos 3:7**
 - **Joel 2:28-30**
