

Spiritual Grade Card for Teachers

The following self-administered checklist provides the teacher with a means of assessing the degree to which they have been effective in meeting the spiritual needs of the students in their classroom.

Personal Accountability Checklist:

1. Personal prayer time
2. Sharing ones personal testimony
3. Praying with students
4. Getting to know students personally
5. Church involvement (Using my gifts to minister to my church)
6. Involvement in outreach (giving Bible studies, etc.)
7. Exhibiting the joy of serving God
8. Demonstrating Christian based attitudes in relationship in co-worker relationships
9. Visioning (a. knowing what God wants you to do and what He wants you to accomplish.
b. having a vision for your school. c. Helping students see their place in God's work.)

Classroom Accountability Checklist:

1. Classroom worship
2. Integrating God into Daily Lesson Plan
3. Integrating Bible texts/stories into the curriculum.
4. Allowing prayer time during class
5. Inclusion of Bible study in the content area
6. Sharing Salvation
Discussing Salvation
Discussing church beliefs
7. Encouraging positive Christian attitudes between students (language, etc.)
8. Providing opportunities for students to serve others
9. Providing opportunities for students to bring salvation to others.
10. Encouraging students to ask God for guidance in finding His purpose for their life.
11. Developing a Biblical theme for each unit studied.
